## Dear Parents, Students and Staff,

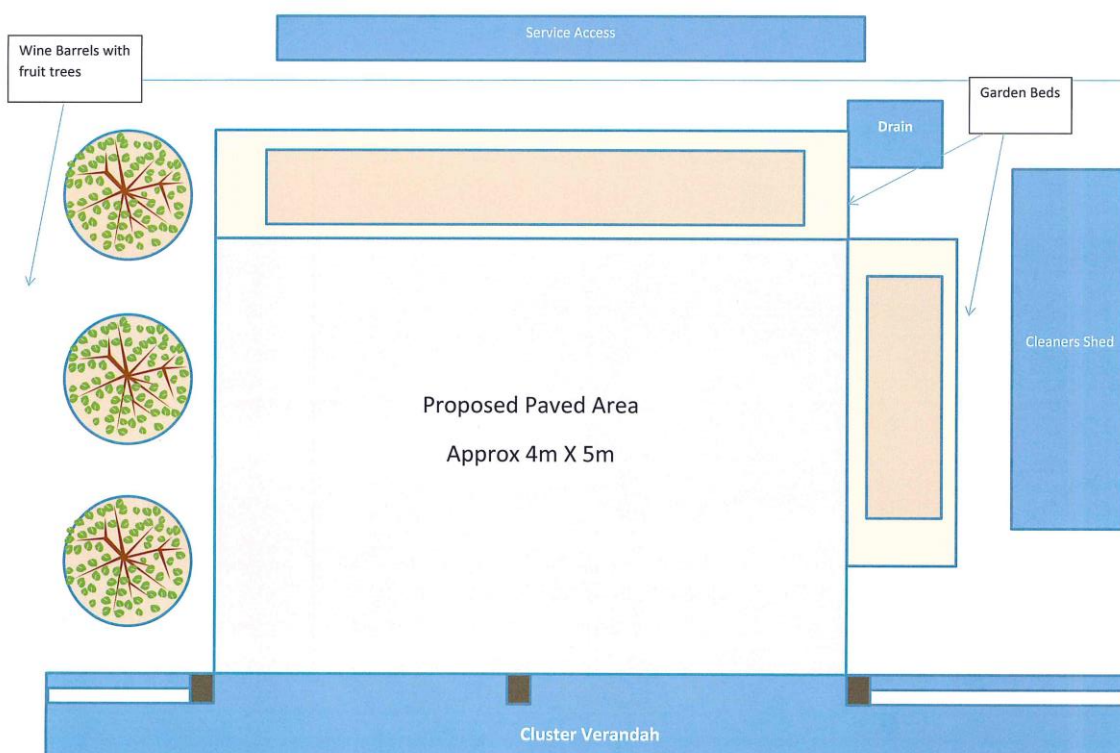

## Kindy Enrolments

### Friday 21 July is an important date in your child's education

Families need to apply to enrol their children in a public school for 2018 if they are:

- starting Kindergarten – 4 years old by 30 June 2018
- starting Pre-primary (first year of compulsory school) – 5 years old by 30 June 2018
- starting Year 7 (first year of secondary school)
- changing schools.

All children from Pre-primary to Year 12 are guaranteed a place at their local public school.

## Mandarin Cooking Day

In our language classes, we are looking forward to celebrating the Dragon Boat festival in the next few weeks after having worked hard in performing the oral assessment task for this semester. We shall be making paper dragon boats and decorating them. We shall also learn the significance of this Chinese festival. On Monday and Tuesday of next week we will be also be doing some cooking. This is also as part of GFT for Mandarin. At this stage, the menu is fried wontons. They are little parcels of seasoned meat (chicken) with Chinese cabbage and aromatics wrapped in square pieces of skins made out of wheat flour. We had them last year and they were a hit. Senior students might also have the opportunity to learn to do a vegetable stir-fry with the emphasis on learning some of the names of Chinese vegetables.

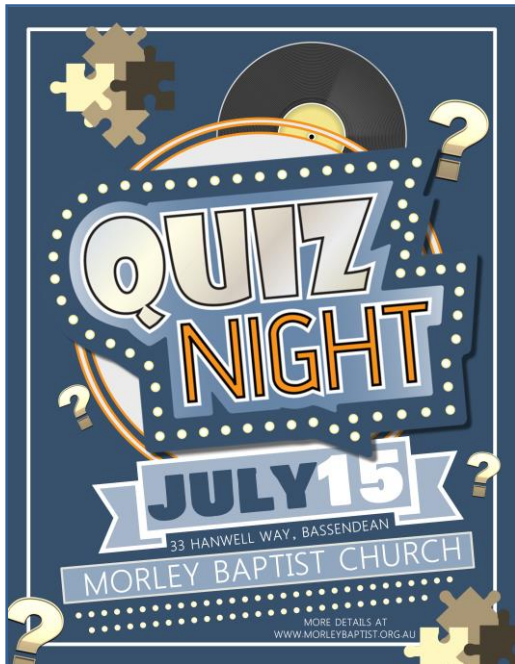
